At least 24 cards are included; often more.

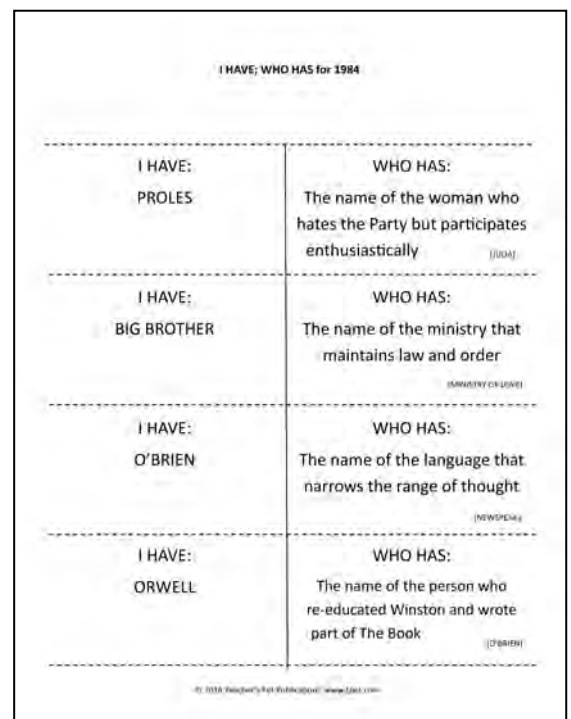
