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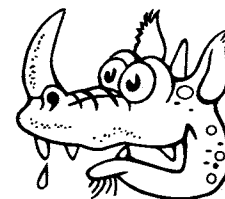
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## Expectations

The student will:

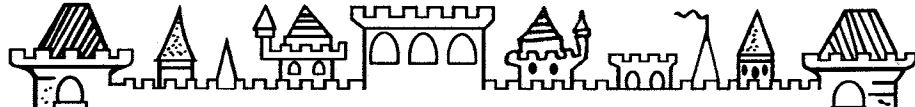
- develop a positive reading attitude.

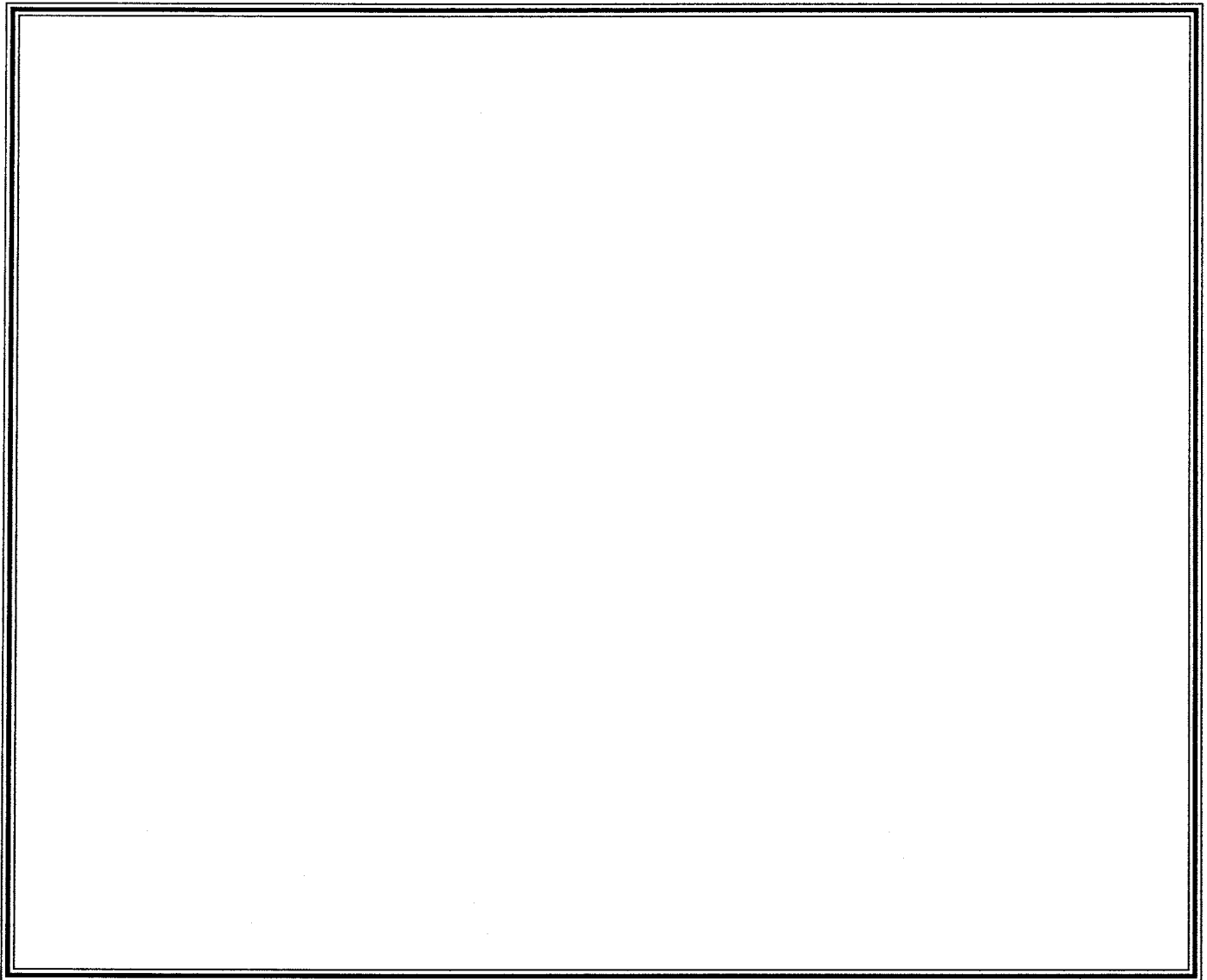


1. Where did Elizabeth live?

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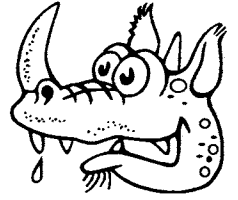
Draw a picture of Elizabeth and Ronald before the dragon came.

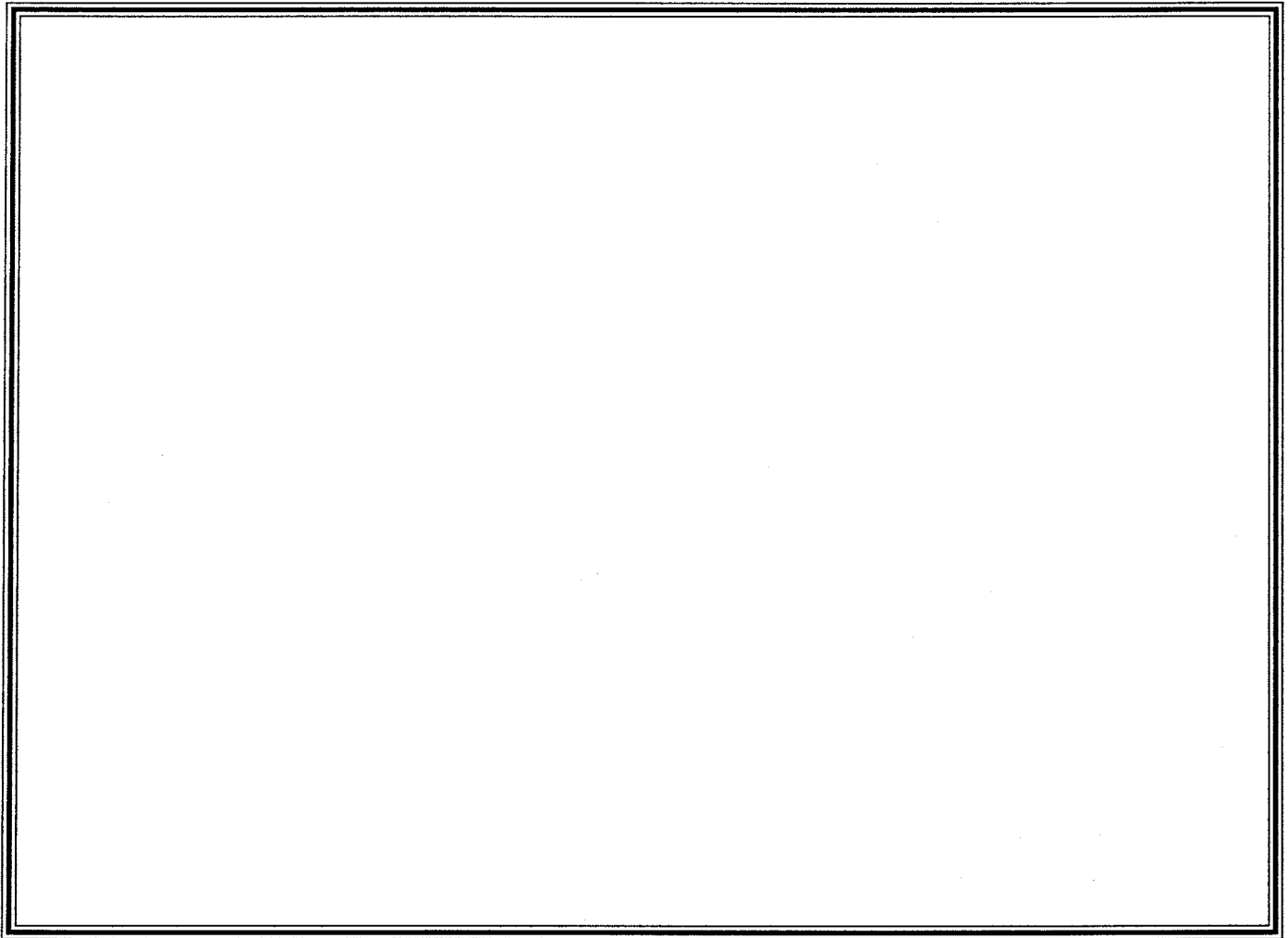
2. What did the dragon do to Elizabeth and Ronald?
