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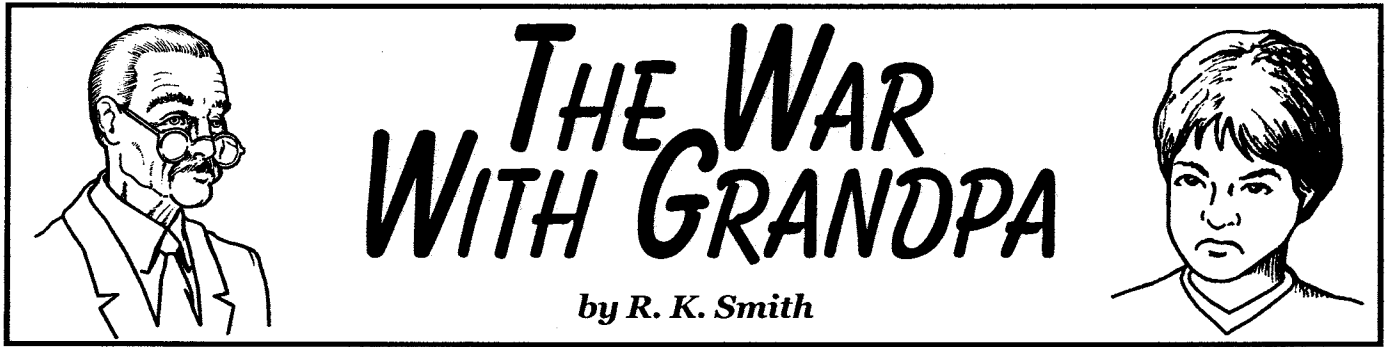


Chapter One - Peter Stokes's True and Real Story

a) Illustrate the inside of your bedroom showing the furniture and the location of the windows and door.

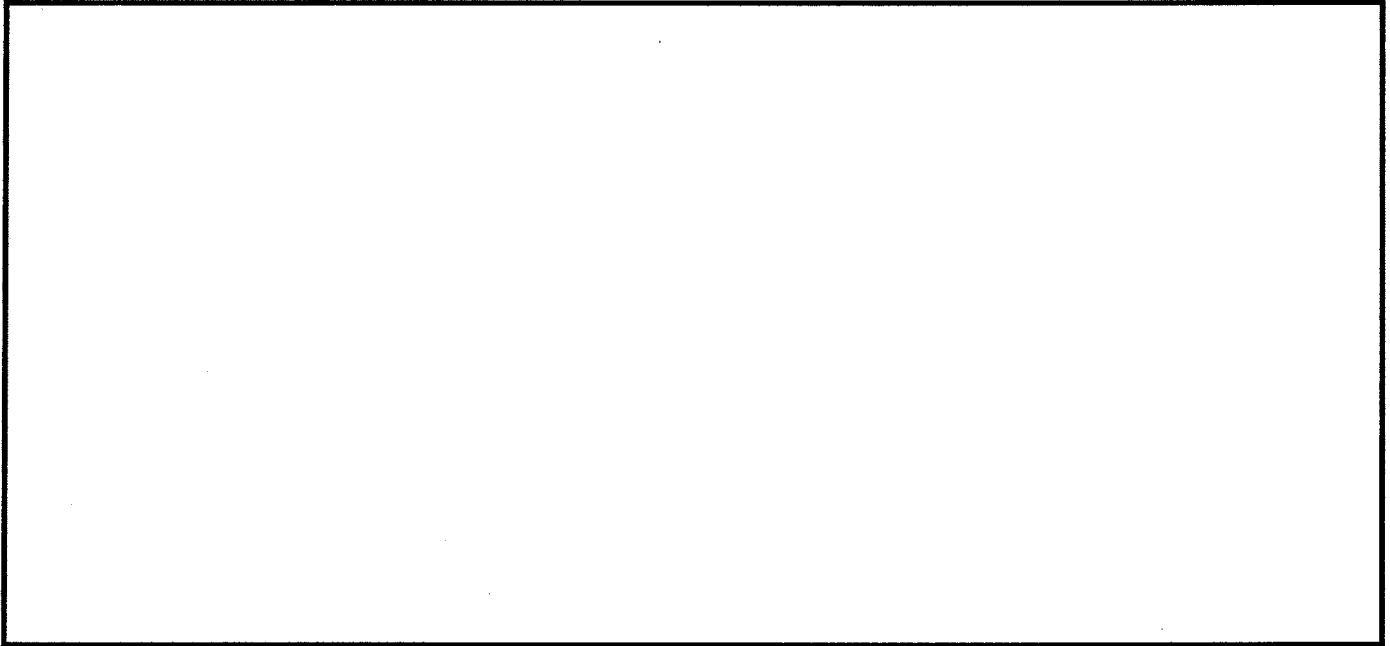
