

- 2. *Briefly summarize the last 50 minutes of Eddie's life in the following segments of minutes: 50, 40, 34, 30, 26, 19, 14, 12. Why do you think Albom gives a "countdown" of the last hour of Eddie's life?
- 3. *How do children react to Eddie? Why? What do they sometimes call him? What do you think the simile "They drew in like cold hands to a fire" (p. 3) means?
- 4. Identify Joe and Dominguez.
- 5. *Who is Marguerite? Where does Eddie meet her? Explain why you do or do not believe in "love at first sight."
- 6. What are Eddie's final words? How does he die?
- 7. Why is Eddie unable to stop the chain of events that lead to his death?
- 8. *What are the last sounds Eddie hears? Why do you think this is significant?
- 9. Who is Nicky? How does he inadvertently cause Eddie's death?
- 10. *Whose face is the last one Eddie sees on Earth? What is the last thing he feels? Do you think he saved the little girl's life?


- 1. *When is Eddie born? How does his father react? Why do you think this scene is important to the story?


