

Chapter XIII

Theme

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**Chapter XXII** 

Point of View

Objective: Understanding the impact of a character's perspective

Activity

When Miss Van Campen finds all the empty alcohol bottles hidden in Frederick's armoire, she gets very angry with him, but he doesn't seem to take her very seriously. Their conversation is told from Frederick's point of view, so you read his thoughts and feelings as well as hear what he says. However, you hear only what Miss Van Campen says, not her thoughts and feelings. Assume the role of Miss Van Campen, and write a letter to Frederick's superior officer about Frederick's use of alcohol.

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#### **Chapters XXV**

Tone

Objective: Using tone to create mood

Activity 1

When Frederick returns to Gorizia after having been wounded, he describes the setting in detail before he says, "It did not feel like a homecoming." (Pg. 163) He has not spoken to anyone when he comes to this conclusion. As Hemingway does in many of his novels, he uses visual images to create a mood such as Frederick's. Read the description on Pg. 163, and identify the specific images that lead to Frederick feelings about not having a homecoming.

#### **Activity 2**

When someone has been away for a long time, it's nice to feel welcome and happy to be home. However, Frederick was not happy to be back in Gorizia, as he shows in his description of the setting. Assume the role of Hemingway, and pretend that Frederick is happy to be back with your friends in Gorizia. Rewrite the first paragraph of Page 163 in Hemingway's style to portray Frederick's happiness.

Chapter XXVII

Style

Objective: Identifying elements of figurative and literal language

Activity

A literal sentence is one in which its meaning is limited to the meaning of each word in it. A figurative sentence is one in which the meaning is symbolic, often using such literary devices as personification, hyperbole, similes, metaphors, and idioms. Usually you can identify figurative language by its use in a sentence. For example, Frederick says, "The apple was reason." (Pg. 171) An apple cannot be reasonable because reason requires the ability to feel and think; instead this is an example of figurative language.

In your group, review this chapter, and identify phrases that use figurative language to convey a thought. Then write the literal meaning of the phrase and its intended figurative meaning. The first one is done for you.

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#### **Chapter XXIX**

**Styles of Government** 

Objective: Understanding the differences between forms of government

Activity

As this chapter closes, Piani and Bonello are joking around by calling each other anarchists and socialists. When Frederick questions them about this, Bonello says, "We're socialists. We come from Imola." (Pg. 208) Anarchy and socialism are two different philosophies for governing a country. Research the definition and beliefs of the topic your teacher assigns to your group, including its principles, famous leaders, and the advantages and disadvantages of this method of governing. Prepare a presentation for your class.

Activity

Frederick loses one of his close friends in his unit, and Aymo is shot by the Italians, not the Germans or Austrians.
